CORE STRENGTH:

Prayer Changes Everything

1 Timothy 4:7-8 [KJV]

⁷ But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and <u>exercise thyself</u> <u>rather unto godliness</u>. ⁸ For bodily exercise profiteth little: but <u>godliness is profitable unto all things</u>, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

The Exercises that you need to **CONSISTENTLY COMMIT** to:

• The 1st "exercise" that we are going to examine more closely is **PRAYER**.

Why should we pray?

- We pray because <u>INTIMACY</u> only comes through prayer.
- We pray because <u>INSIGHT</u> also comes through prayer.
- We pray because <u>INTERVENTION</u> also comes through prayer.

Dr. Tony Evans defines **PRAYER** as:

"A believer's oral or mental communication with God the Father, through the authority of Jesus Christ, with the assistance of the Holy Spirit."

A BELIEVER'S

- The prayer that honors <u>GOD</u>, and the prayer that God <u>HONORS</u> is the prayer of <u>ONE</u> who believes.
- Being a believer is a <u>PREREQUISITE</u> for prayer.
- ⁶ But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must <u>believe</u> that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. Hebrews 11:6
- ²² And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, <u>believing</u>, ye shall receive. Matthew 21:22

ORAL AND/OR MENTAL COMMUNICATION

- In prayer, we are not just making requests but we are <u>COMMUNING</u>.
- When we are out of <u>COMMUNION</u> with God, we are not COMMUNICATING to God.
- ⁴ Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. John 15:4

WE PRAY IN THE NAME, OR AUTHORITY, OF THE SON JESUS

 Jesus promises to submit our prayers to the Father without a "<u>RETURN TO SENDER</u>" notification.

And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴ You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it. – John 14:13-14

WE PRAY WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

 When we don't know what to pray for, the Holy Spirit assists us by planting desires on our heart.

²⁶ In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans.²⁷ And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God. – Romans 8:26-27
